ISSUE/PROPOSAL STATEMENT: Implement by ordinance a debarment process for entities or individuals who engage in illegal or improper financial conduct (pay-to-play) in connection with obtaining, maintaining or seeking to obtain contracts with the City. State or Federal models should be consulted. The ordinance, at a minimum would:

- establish a debarment period of 10 years
- require entities/persons seeking contracts report any request for pay from elected, appointed or other employees of the City to a designated person and/or department in the City (i.e. Auditor General, Inspector General, etc.)
- require City report any pay-to-play activity to the proper state and/or federal authorities.
