RELEVANT ORDINANCE SECTION: RELEVANT LAW(S):

ISSUE/PROPOSAL STATEMENT: Have City Council meet 12 months per year except recesses two weeks in August and two weeks in December.

RATIONALE: "Citizens have expressed concern that City Council recesses are too long." –Councilwoman Watson, Letter, dated December 4, 2010.

ANALYSIS: Currently City Council meets all year with the exception of three recess periods: (1) in the Spring after the Mayor presents his budget in mid-April; (2) the last two (2) weeks in August, or the entire month of August; and (3) at the end of the year.

DISPOSITION/COMMISION ACTION:
