Sec. 4-402. Powers and duties.

The City Planning Commission serves as the City's zoning commission maintaining the City's zoning ordinance and processing amendments thereto. The commission shall advise the city council on development matters as defined in section 6-204, and perform other functions as directed by the city council. Any resolution adopted by the commission is advisory and shall not be binding until adoption by the city council.
