<u>RATIONALE</u>: "I believe it is paramount to the integrity and transparency of the appointment process that both the public and municipal workers be able to discern the salary and responsibilities of Executive and Legislative appointees, and whether unintentional or not, there is no possibility in the future of employing multiple titles to conceal the salary of an appointee."-Councilman Cockrel, Letter dated October 14, 2010.
